## <u>COUNTRY COTTAGE ESTATES HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.</u> Resolution - Fines for Ongoing Violation(s) of CCE Covenants, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations

A meeting of the Country Cottage Estates Homeowners' Association, Inc. (CCHOA) Board of Directors was held at 105 Gretchen Ct., Montz, LA 70068 on August 29, 2022. A discussion concerning ongoing violations involving various Owners from time-to-time who, despite repeated notification(s) and assessment(s) of existing fines by the Association for said ongoing violations, fail to comply even after implementation of all three existing fine levels. In a further attempt to remedy such ongoing violations, the Board voted to adopt a 4<sup>th</sup> level of fines as follows:

### IT WAS RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Association has attempted to gain compliance of various Association Covenants, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations by assessing offending Owner(s) with initial notice(s) of violation(s) followed by assessment of the three existing levels of fines for failure to comply, specifically 1<sup>st</sup> violation \$50.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> violation \$100.00 and third violation \$150.00. Despite those efforts, there have been repeated occasions were the violation(s) continued, in some cases with absolutely no response from the offending Owner(s).
- 2. In cases where an Owner fails to respond and/or comply by correcting the violation(s) and bring its property into compliance with Association Covenants, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations after the third level of existing fine has been assessed, the Association shall henceforth assess the offending Owner with a weekly fine of \$100.00 for each ongoing violation until said violation(s) are corrected by Owner and the property is brought into compliance with Association Covenants, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations.
- 3. Failure of Owner to pay said fine(s) shall result in the Association pursing the matter as provided for under existing Association Covenants, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations.
- 4. If any portion of the aforementioned fine level is adjudged unenforceable, all remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. Except as herein otherwise provided for, all previously existing references to fines within existing Association Covenants, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations shall remain unchanged and in full force.
